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**ALL YOUTH REGISTRATION** includes camping, patch and activities. Scouts will also have an opportunity to attend the SLACK (morning rodeo) for free at the Sheriff's Rodeo. Tag Alongs/siblings are free if under the age of 5.

**LEADERSHIP:** Two deep leadership – [The Guide to Safe Scouting](#) requires a minimum of 2 adult leaders with each unit during any activity. One adult must be registered and over 21 years old; the second must be 18 years or older. The chartered organization is responsible for ensuring sufficient leadership is provided for all activities. Youth Protection training must be current.

**CUB SCOUT FAMILY CAMPING GUIDELINES:** Each youth member will be under the supervision of a parent or legal guardian. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children, and Youth Protection guidelines apply. In special circumstances, a Cub Scout whose parent or legal guardian is not able to attend an overnight camping trip may participate under the supervision of another registered adult member of the BSA who is a parent of a Cub Scout who is also attending. The unit leader and a parent or legal guardian must agree to the arrangement, and all Youth Protection policies apply. At no time may another adult accept responsibility for more than one additional "non-family member" youth.

**LEADERS GUIDE:** A complete leader's guide and all other necessary forms including BSA Annual Health & Medical Form and Parent/Guardian Consent Form will be available on the council website. Completed forms must be presented for review during check-in.

**NO SMOKING:** Smoking will not be permitted at this event.

**ALCOHOL& PETS:** No alcoholic beverages or pets are permitted on site.
