- Medical/ Consent Forms part (A&B). **EVERYONE** needs to fill out these forms to participate. These forms will be given to our Camp Nurse and returned to you at Checkout. These forms can be found at www.scouting.org/health-and-safety/ahmr/
- There is **NO Camping Inside** vehicles. All Lion, Tigers and adult campers must be in a campsite. You will need to bring; a tent, sleeping bag, pillow, change of clothes, hat, jacket, toiletries, camp chair, and a flashlight. Please bring a water bottle, we will provide water.
- Meals: **Please bring a sack lunch for Saturday.** Saturday dinner and Sunday breakfast will be provided. We will also provide snacks. **NO FOOD IN TENTS** we have resourceful critters who will damage tents, backpacks, etc. to get to the food.
- Bathrooms: BSA has a policy that youth and adults use different facilities and women/girls must be separate from the men/boys. There is 1 set of bathrooms close to the campsites. Outside of the restrooms, there will be a sign. If your child goes into the bathroom, please flip the sign to say "Boy". If you are going, please flip the sign to say "Men". This will be the same for the women and the girls. We follow all Youth Protection guidelines.
