Thank you for your interest in using the California Inland Empire Council High Adventure Team Climbing Kit. The unit must provide the names of Boy Scouts of America (BSA) certified climbing directors or instructors who will accompany the unit to supervise all climbing activities during the outing, is expected to comply with the relevant BSA youth protection policies and requirements of Climb on Safely, provide a completed climbing emergency plan, and is responsible to return all borrowed items.

The kit contains the following items:

- Helmets (6)
- Harness (6)
- Rappel devices (6)
- ATC belay devices (2)
- Grigri (1)
- Locking carabiners (12)
- Ropes (4)
- Belay gloves (2)
- Safety slings (6)
- 1" sling 30-foot (1)
- 1" sling 60-foot (1)

The fee for using the kit is \$50.00 for weekend of use for up to three days. The fee for longer usage is \$10 per day, for a maximum of four additional days. Kits must be returned within two days after the rental period. A fee of \$25 per day will be charged for each day late. The unit will be billed for the cost of replacing any item not returned with the kit or that has been misused or abused during the outing.
