INTRODUCTION TO OUTDOOR LEADER SKILLS gives Boy Scout leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts and to learn how they might teach them to the youth under their charge. The sessions



closely follow the Boy Scout Handbook. Upon completion of this course and the earlier one, Specific Training for Scoutmasters and Assistants, the leader is considered Trained and earns the Trained patch.
