

# Dodgers Boy Scouts Egg Drop Eggstravaganza!

## Schedule of Events

1:30PM – 2:00PM	Check-In
2:00PM – 4:00PM	Egg Drop
4:30PM – 5:00PM	Centerfield Recognition

## Check-In

Parking: Cars will enter through the Sunset Gate at 1:30 P.M. at the intersection of Stadium Way and Elysian Park Ave. Upon entering, you must park in Lot 7. For directions and to pre-purchase parking (\$5 discount), go to [www.dodgers.com/parking](http://www.dodgers.com/parking)

Check-In Time: Every Scout must check-in between 1:30 P.M and 2:00 P.M. Scouts who arrive after 2:00PM will be ineligible to participate.

Check-In Area: Every Scout must check-in at the Right Field Entrance which is located in Lot G. Please note: you cannot park in Lot G.

Boy Scout Patches: There will be a patch pick-up station next to the check-in area.

## Egg Drop

Goal: Don't break Humpty! All scouts who participate in the Egg Drop will be recognized in Centerfield during the Dodgers pre-game!

Preparation: Scouts should design their apparatus for the egg drop either at home or at a group meeting. DO NOT SEAL the container until AFTER it has been inspected at the check in table. Use your best judgment for the materials used.

Egg Drop Event: The event will begin at 2:00 P.M. Each scouts' entry will be dropped off the Reserve Level by assigned personnel. This is a 6 ½ Story Drop! Each device that's dropped will be inspected for unbroken eggs. The event will end approximately at 4:00 P.M.

## Pre-game Ceremony Centerfield Recognition

\* At the conclusion of the Egg Drop event, all participants will head over and lineup behind our Left Field Plaza entrance starting from 4PM.

\* Participants must come in their Boy Scouts uniform.

\*Additional information will be given at check in.



## Egg Drop Rules

In order to participate in the Egg Drop, Scouts must have a ticket to the August 23rd game. Tickets may include an entire troop, family members and friends.

### RULES:

- ➔ NO Parachutes
- ➔ NO Metal Containers
- ➔ NO Liquids or Gels
- ➔ NO Glass

\*Each Troop must have at least one chaperone in attendance at the Egg Drop.

\*The largest box size allowed is 12" x 12".

\*Each package must be clearly marked with the Scout's name and Unit Number (Pack or Troop number)

\*All Boxes will be inspected inside and out before the competition, MAKE SURE THE BOX IS NOT SEALED UNTIL AFTER INSPECTION (bring tape and extra supplies for sealing).

\*Scouts must provide their own raw chicken egg.

## Additional Prizes for the Egg Drop Contest:

Prizes will be awarded for the following contests:

1. Dodger Spirit
  - a. This award will be given to the device that shows the most Dodger Spirit.
2. Smallest Device
  - a. This award will be given to the smallest device that successfully completes the Egg Drop.
3. Best Design
  - a. This award will be given to the device with the most unique/original design that successfully completes the Egg Drop.
