This program meets the requirements for the Boy Scouts of America's Rifle merit badge and is run by trained and registered BSA merit badge counselors. Shooters can work on their shooting portion of the Rifle Merit Badge. (Due to time constraints, it is recommended that the non-shooting portions of the rifle merit badge be completed prior to the shoot.)

Shooters will have the opportunity to earn levels of competency in the NRA Marksmanship Program (*light rifle category*). This program provides incentive awards for developing and improving marksmanship skills. Performance is measured against standards established by the Marksmanship program and any shooter who meets or exceeds the standards receives corresponding recognition awards for that rating.

Award packet includes a certificate of achievement for the corresponding level achieved as well as a medal. This NRA marksmanship medal is the only Non-BSA medal that may be worn on the scout uniform.

The range also has camping facilities including a camping area, covered picnic area, Porta-Poty's, Charcoal BBQ grill and fire pit (usage subject to local fire warnings).

<u>Purpose</u> - The Junior Shoot is designed to give youths a solid foundation for learning how to safely shoot a rifle and enjoy the spirit of competition with other youth. Young men and women to learn the following skills during these shoots:

- Basics of gun handling (Mandatory one time session, before they can shoot)
- Shooting skills and Techniques
- Different rifle shooting positions used in competition (Advanced shooters)
- How to score targets
- Match etiquette

<u>Shoot Description</u> – Shooting will be from the bench rest position. Each shooter will fire at targets at a predetermined distance using rifles, ammunition and safety gear supplied by the club.

<u>Shoot Date, Time & Cost</u> - 4th Saturday of the month, Shooting starts at 9:00AM <u>Cost is <u>FREE!!!!</u> All equipment and ammunition is provided.</u>

In order to attend the shoot. Juniors will be required to present a CSC Junior Liability Release signed by a parent or legal guardian. **We can not waive this requirement for anyone** so please make sure the youth has this form with them on the day of the shoot.

BSA Troops - If you would like to camp Friday evening before the shoot, let us know in advance as gates are normally locked from Dusk until Dawn. (This option is temporarily unavailable)
