




Log on to myscouting.org. If this is your first time, create username and password.




If you are a first time user or returning user, go to "Update My Profile"




After confirming your contact information, make sure that your profile is linked with our council, which is the CALIFORNIA INLAND EMPIRE COUNCIL, #045. As a Cub Scout Leader, it is easy to get 100% trained since all of the necessary training is online.




First, click on "E-Learning"


To be 100% trained, a leader has to complete Leader Specific Training for their registered position (Den Leader, Committee Member, Cubmaster, etc) and have completed youth protection within the last 2 years.




Each training takes roughly 30-45 minutes to complete, and is available is Spanish as well as English



For the leaders and units records, it is recommended that the leader prints their trained certificate
